1,000 members of the public who "Have a significant interest in the sport of Golf"

Age Range: 18-99

Locations: England, Scotland and Wales

Collection Time: January 20th 2021

Headline Stats:

- 60% of golfers want to see courses reopen in England & Wales immediately.
 - 56% of Scottish golfers want their courses to remain open while keeping English courses shut.
 - 20% of English golfers want to see Scottish courses shut.
 - 3% of middle-aged (45-60) golfers want Scottish courses shut.
 - 18% of golfers openly admit to witnessing coronavirus transmission risks.

Key Questions and Results:

What is the best COVID-19 Policy for golf courses?

19% - Nothing should change

21% - Scotland should close their golf courses

60% - England and Wales should reopen their golf courses

Scottish Golfers: Should English courses remain closed?

71% - Yes

29% - No

Scottish Golfers: Should Scottish courses close?

21% - Yes

79% - No
